

TICKET INFORMATION

University of Wisconsin-Platteville Commencement

All guests attending the commencement ceremonies on May 8, 2010 must have a ticket for admission to the Williams Fieldhouse (aka Bo Ryan Court). Seating for guests will be on the Fieldhouse bleachers.

Ticket Reservations

Ticket reservations will begin at 2:30 pm on March 10, 2010 (during "Countdown to Commencement") at the University Box Office located on the lower level of Ullsvik Hall. Only degree candidates confirmed by the Registrar's Office may reserve tickets. A maximum of four tickets may be requested per degree candidate.

Distance Learning students may reserve seating by calling the box office at 608-342-1298.

Regular Box Office hours are Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.; Tuesday from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. and Saturday from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

Any seats not reserved by April 9, 2010 will be released. Degree candidates may request up to four additional tickets (combined maximum of eight seats) beginning April 12, 2010 at the University Box Office. These additional tickets are subject to availability.

Ticket pick-up

Ticket pick-up for seats previously reserved begins May 3, 2010 at the University Box Office. A photo-id is required to pick-up tickets. Any tickets not picked up by Friday, May 7th will be available for pick-up on the day of the ceremony in the Williams Fieldhouse lobby. **Lost tickets may not be reprinted.**

Special Needs

If a guest requires special seating (e.g. wheelchair, difficulty with stairs), please inform the box office when reserving seats. One companion is permitted to sit with a guest requiring special needs seating. This seating is subject to availability.

Seating Times

The morning ceremony for the College of Business, Industry, Life Science & Agriculture and the School of Graduate Studies will begin seating at 8:30 a.m. and the ceremony will begin at 9:30 a.m.

The afternoon ceremony for the College of Engineering, Mathematics & Science and the College of Liberal Arts and Education will begin seating at 1:00 p.m. and the ceremony will begin at 2:00 p.m.

Guests who arrive after the processional begins at the published ceremony start time will be required to remain in the lobby until the graduates, faculty, and stage party have been seated.

Options for Guests Without Tickets

Any guests without tickets may view the ceremony from the overflow area in the Pioneer Student Center or Doudna Hall. The ceremony will also be broadcast on cable television channel 5 and on the internet via streaming video. A link for the video feed will be available from the UWP Home page (www.uwplatt.edu).
